EANS

The EANS program offers vital support to non-public elementary and secondary schools through two key funding allocations:

What is EANS I

As part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER II) fund under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act (December 2020), EANS I provides \$2.75 billion in funding. This allocation prioritizes non-public schools that enroll a high percentage of low-income students and have been heavily impacted by COVID-19. Schools can be reimbursed for eligible expenses incurred since March 13, 2020.

What is EANS II

EANS II offers an additional \$2.75 billion through the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, enacted in March 2021. Under this second allocation, State Education Agencies (SEAs) provide services or assistance to non-public schools that also serve a large number of low-income students impacted by the pandemic. Unlike EANS I, EANS II does not allow reimbursements for expenses.



How Can EANS funds be used?

- Enhancing existing technology
- Develop and implement curricula or programs that promote student success
- Training and professional development for staff as well as hiring additional staff.
- Providing support services to students, such as mental health, counseling or transportation and much more...
