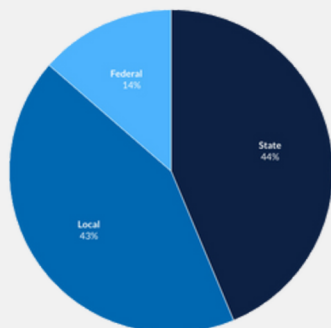


State Level Funding

Public schools serving students from kindergarten through 12th grade (K-12) are funded by a mix of local, state, and federal sources, with the distribution varying both across and within states. In the 2022 fiscal year, the total spending on public K-12 education reached \$857 billion from all funding sources.

The federal government plays a relatively small, but important role in K-12 education funding

The majority of funding—86 percent—comes from state and local governments. State governments use specific formulas to allocate education funding to school districts, which then combine these state funds with additional revenue from federal and local sources to support individual schools.
